What's new with Cliqbook:

Total Itinerary Cost – This has been automatically enabled to total estimated cost of a total trip on the traveler's itinerary. The estimated total includes the costs of all flight, rail, hotel, car, parking and taxi segments combined. Car, hotel, and taxi rate do not include taxes and gratuity.

Specify Airline in Air Search – When this feature is enabled, the user can elect to specify an airline they would like searched. Cliqbook will add this airline to the search as a "User Preferred" – and in many cases will result in more options for that airline, although in reality, the difference may be negligible. The matrix at the top of the search results will default to the selected airline.

Company Location Search – In November, Concur changed the way Company Locations work. Where there are more than 25 locations, an auto-complete search field would be provided to avoid a long drop down menu. This can now be configurable and can be changed back to the old way of displaying company locations in a drop-down format.

Suppress Emails – When enabled on your site, Cliqbook will suppress emails that are sent when travel assistants are added or changed in a profile.

Hub Airport Search – When enabled, Cliqbook will run an additional search on the main hub if the user has chosen one of the associated airports.

Airline/Hotel preference – Three tiers of diamonds. Airline and hotel discounts loaded with "most preferred" will display with three diamonds, discounts loaded with "preferred" will display with two diamonds and discounts loaded with "less preferred" will display with one diamond. **Custom text can be written to advise your travelers of vendors that are listed as Most Preferred, Preferred and/or less preferred.

User Supplied Hotels – "Add to an Existing Reservation" allows travelers to add hotel information to their itinerary that was not originally booked in Cliqbook.

Concur Mobile – Icon added to note concur mobile enabled. This appears on the "Upcoming Trips" tab and on the Travel Itinerary as a reminder that upcoming trips are viewable using Concur Mobile

Coming soon: Amtrak will soon be a direct connect. Cliqbook is planning for a May, 2010 implementation. What this means to you and your travelers is that you will be able to search and book all Amtrak rail stations and tickets will be issued electronically.
